## WARMER DAYS AHEAD ....

We understand change can sometimes be difficult, but these changes are vital in the effort to improve overall experience at the club. After thoroughly reviewing the Member Surveys, numerous discussion with members, public as well as representatives of the Men's and Women's Clubs and our staff, we are implementing a number of changes starting during the month of March.

- One of the most significant changes in the short term is to allow members more access to the tee sheet for bookings by reducing group blocks. We have collectively decided to shift Men's League, Women's League as well as Razz tee time blocks to reduce the number blocked tee times to allow more members access on any given day. ## FOCUS ON THE GOLF COURSE

Thank you to all of you who have taken such care and cooperation with roped off areas on the golf course. As we move into March, it is vital to keep off these areas for the near future. As soon as the weather allows, we have developed a plan for seeding and applying sod to a number of these trouble areas.

Please continue to consider these areas as 'Ground Under Repair' or 'No Play Zones'. We need all play and carts to be off of these areas. Although the vast majority have followed the parameters, we have had to issue a handful of warnings and hope to not have to suspend anyone. Below are the previously implemented parameters:

No cart is to be driven within the areas that are roped off, and golf balls are not to be played within the roped off areas. Please take nearest point of relief without penalty.

In addition, please keep golf carts in front of any areas that have directional cart signs, especially away from greens and beside tee boxes. The only way that we are able to improve conditions in these areas are by eliminating cart traffic as well as the significant efforts of the grounds crew.

If by chance you have a medical issue limiting mobility, please contact our Director of Golf, Greg Adams, in the Golf Shop with sufficient documentation, and accommodations will be made to designate a notification for your cart.

Our team will be monitoring the golf course for the unlikely event that any players do not abide by these parameters. We are sure that all play, both members and public alike, will be accommodating to the efforts made to improve the course. In the unlikely circumstance that the above parameters are ignored; in which a cart is seen by staff inside these roped off areas, on tee boxes or adjacent to greens inside the cart directional signs or within the roped off areas:

- There will be only one warning which will be documented on the first occurrence.
- If a second occurrence is witnessed by staff, there will be a disciplinary action of suspension of play for 1 week that will be administered whether public or member.

We look forward to being able to improve the course conditions and overall member experience at the club in the coming months.

# MEMBER BOOKING PARAMETERS

Through discussions with members and staff, it appears there are a number of members that have had difficulty getting tee times during prime hours of the day. In addition to alleviating some blocks with the league and Razz play, we have discovered that some parameters for member booking needed to be put in place going forward:

- A limit to 4 future tee time bookings in total at any one time
- A limit to a booking of 1 tee time with 4 players for every member per day (unless playing 36 holes). If more than 4 players are requested, either a separate member must make the booking, or you can request via Greg Adams with all names of the players.
- Names for each player are required and whether the player is a member or guest.
- **24 hour cancellation policy.** If a group does not cancel or reduce the number of players not going to be playing prior to 24 hours, a \$45 cancellation fee will be billed to your account per player booked. *Accommodations may be made for adverse or extenuating circumstances including weather.*

In an effort to provide better customer service in the golf shop by reducing phone calls for bookings; we would encourage you to book through the member portal on the website instead of calling the club if possible. If you need help with a login, or directions on how to book through the member portal, please contact Greg Adams, or one of the Golf Shop staff for assistance.

# MEMBER ACCOUNTS

In an effort to stem the growing list of member account receivables, we will be implementing new conditions for all members starting March 1, 2023.

#### 2 Free Guest Rounds for adding a CC

For any member who adds a credit card or ACH to their member account during the month of March, they will receive 2 Free Guest Rounds for 2023. (Only applicable to members who currently do not have a credit card or ACH account on file). Credit cards/ ACH will be automatically billed monthly for any monthly dues or purchases charged to their account during each month.

#### **Overdue Accounts**

- Any past due accounts as of March 1, will be fully suspended from play, booking and practice privileges until full payment is received.
- Past due accounts not paid by the 15th of the month will be suspended pending payment.



- If a member is either 30 days past due, or has their account past due twice in the calendar year, membership will be suspend until full payment is received along with either ACH or credit card to be automatically billed monthly for any charges or purchases going forward.
- 18% interest will be charged on past due accounts on the 16th of each

# WALKING & DOG WALKING ACCESS ON THE COURSE

Thank you to the members who have reduced walking and dog walking during operational hours.

We will be forwarding a letter to the surrounding community newsletter to notify and remind community members as well.

A reminder: Walking is ONLY after operational hours of the golf course.

PGC will continue to allow community residents to walk BEFORE or AFTER operational hours ONLY, and only when there are no golfers on the course. We would assume that there is still a small group of people that happen to not be following the guidelines, and hope that we are able to continue to allow access after hours for walking...

**HOWEVER** if non golfers continue to not follow the rules posted in the future, and continue to impact operations, access will be removed.

As members, we need your help: please inform the Golf Shop if you see any walking/dog walking during operational hours at the time of infraction so the situation can be addressed.

#### GREEN RECOVERY...

As you may have seen, there had been some damage to the back of the 16th and 18th greens during the fall of 2022.

Nick and his team are continuing to implement ground under repair in these areas, and as the ground temperatures hopefully gets warmer this month, we will be able to see more growth and will be able to address these areas more aggressively.

In the meantime, please play these areas as ground under repair and limit walking on these areas.

#### FORWARD TEES...

In February, we tested a handful of forward tees, with mixed feedback from members.

The forward tees will continue to be periodically be placed on the right side of the 15th fairway.

Considering the length of the hole, we will be using this position as a tee periodically. The hole distance will be noted in the golf shop, but in general the 15th hole will play between 100 and 115 yds from the fairway tee.
