

POOL OPENS MAY 20TH!

Make sure to get your pool memberships before pool season opens May 20th!

The pool area will be re-keyed for the 2023 season. Notice will be sent via email to all members needing pool access once the new keys are available for pickup.

Due to the number of keys that went missing last year, we will be requiring a deposit of \$25 per key, that will be refundable at the end of year once the pool key is returned to the Golf Shop.

What's in my Bag

The clubs that I am using for this season are all made by PING. I have had the good fortune to be affiliated with PING for over 20 years now. The i525 forged irons are very good looking as well as very user friendly. The feel of the clubs is exactly what you would expect from the top equipment engineering company in the game. As well, the off-center hits are very productive for a what we call a player's iron and allow you to play your best!!

GOLF COURSE REHABILITATION

The sod and seeding project is ongoing on a number of areas of the course. Many small areas have already been completed in the past few weeks as well as larger areas such as behind #9 green, adjacent to #6 green as well as #5 green/#6tee.

In addition to our sod projects, a few areas have been aerified, re-seeded and fertilized such as the #11, 13 and #16 fairways as well as the rear portions of #16 green and #18 green.

Nick and his team will be working in the direction of the 15th green and have identified other areas on the back nine to be targeted with sod and/or seed in the coming weeks. Please make sure to stay out of any of the rehabilitation areas that have been roped off and/or marked with paint. These areas are to be played as ground under repair until the roping has been removed.

Irrigation and Drainage Projects

New perimeter irrigation heads have been installed around #10 green for improved turf conditions, and a similar project is planned to begin on the #9 green in the coming weeks.

We have received our new trencher and are planning to address a few drainage issues shortly including the low marsh area near #6 green as well as the approach area on #18 fairway.

Spring Aeration

To reduce the impact to play during the beautiful weather in late spring, no large core aeration will be done on the greens this spring/early summer season. We will be aerifying monthly using ninja tines, which have almost no impact to play, to help with turf conditions. The team will also be vertical cutting the greens monthly through the season as well.

Reminder: please stay away from the tees and greens with carts, and to follow all signage on the course. Our team will monitoring the golf course for the unlikely event that any players do not abide by these parameters. We are sure that all play, both members and public alike, will be accommodating to the efforts made to improve the course.

Thank you all in advance for your continued cooperation and patronage at Prescott Golf Club.

GREEN RECOVERY...

As you may have seen, there had been some damage to the back of the 16th and 18th greens during the fall of 2022. With the weather finally improved, we have been able to aerify, seed and fertilize these areas. We expect to continue to see significant improvement in the next few weeks.

PAR 3 CARTS...

Considering the landing areas and length of a number of our par 3s at PGC, and at the request of many members...

We have moved the cart signs and roping on some of the par 3 holes; such as #3, #12 and #15; so that players are able to drive on the fairways on the par 3s UP TO & NOT BEYOND either the rope and/or the directional cart signs.

Please keep all carts outside of any ropes, and before any directional cart signs.



WALKING & DOG WALKING ACCESS ON THE COURSE

In the past, PGC ownership has generously allowed walking access to community residents ONLY after operational hours of the golf course.

It appears that the rules implemented, as seen on the sign to the left, have been abused as of late, with a number of individuals seen walking and/or walking their dogs while golfers are playing.

In a number of instances, walkers have been seen on the course during operational hours have impeded play, and in some instances not cleaned up after their dogs etc.

PGC will continue to allow community residents to walk BEFORE or AFTER operational hours ONLY, and only when there are no golfers on the course.

We would assume that this is a small group of people that happen to not be following the guidelines, and hope that we are able to continue to allow access after hours for walking...

HOWEVER if non golfers continue to not follow the rules posted in the future, and continue to impact operations, access will be removed.

As you may have noticed this past weekend, we have just replaced our pin flags for the season with a red, white, and blue color scheme to coincide with pin locations. We will continue to use the number system for pin locations as well. #1 will be a Front, Middle, Back rotation, #2 will be a Middle, Back, Front rotation, #3 to be a Back, Front, Middle rotation.

Flag Color Pin Position

Red Checker Front
White checker: Middle
Blue Checker Back

Even more menu changes are on the way...


We will have some great new additions to our menu for Summer! Shrimp Ceviche always goes great for a summertime appetizer and will be back again this summer!
